1. What is a personal prayer?

2. Types of personal prayers

a. Personal thanks-giving prayer

Is prayer said to thank God for something he has done e.g. healing.

b. Confession prayer

Is a prayer said to ask God to forgiveness.

c. Petition prayer

Is prayer said to ask for daily needs e.g. healing, food, shelter etc.

d. Intercession prayer;

Is a prayer where one prays for others.

2. **Examples of parables used by Jesus.**
 - The parable of the sower (Mark 4:1-9)
 - Parable of the lost son prodigal son (Luke15:11-31)
 - Parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:25-37)
 - Parable of the ten virgins(Matt25:1-13)
 - Parable of the lost coin(Luke15:8-10)
 - Parable of the lost sheep(Luke15:1-7)
 - Parable of the talents (Matt25:1-13)
 - Parable of the tenants(Luke20:9-16) etc
3. **Jesus used parables because;**
 - He didn't want others to know what he was saying.
 - For the disciples to understand well.
 - To fulfill what was said about him.
