



Weather vs Climate?


- Weather: Atmospheric conditions (temperature, rainfall, etc...) at a <u>specific</u> point in time (weather can change at any time).
- Climate: Atmospheric conditions
 (temperature, rainfall, etc...) of a region
 over a long period of time (over the period of a year
 or longer).




Zones of Latitude

- A region's <u>latitude</u> (distance from the equator) has a direct impact on its climate (closer to the equator = warmer / further from the equator = colder)....usually!







Topography - Elevation

- Elevation = height above sea level
- The higher the elevation of a region the cooler the temperature becomes...further
